It was great to see the winners of our awards as so many of our students worked so hard to excel. A big thank-you to our parents for supporting us, our teachers for their hard work at teaching and supporting the learning of our students and to our students for their hard work in their areas of success. A big thank-you to Mrs. Webster for organizing the evening and our Dept. Leaders for their involvement in handing out the awards.

Of interest I thought you may be interested in the fact that over 130 of our students here at ATSS have registered for summer school this year. This is the highest representation for all of the schools in the district. Kudos to our students for wanting to get ahead but I wanted to point out to you as parents that this does play a challenging role for our timetabling in the fall. Our courses for the timetable are all built based on the students' choices from March and April. For those of our students who successfully take a summer school course, this changes their course requirements but we cannot make adjustments to the timetable after the spring. This may result in your son or daughter not being able to get another course they want because it was placed in a position in the timetable based on these earlier selections. I thought you may be interested in this fact which does explain why there may be additional timetable challenges in the fall as your son or daughter may want to make changes but may well be limited.

# In the news... ATSS at the Run for Water 2017

Perry was then selected as a team leader for recruiting and organizing other volunteers to man the parking lots, help direct traffic in the lots, open gates for school teams, and set up signs around the parking lots for the run. Perry was successful in recruiting Sachleen Rai, Jaspinder Chattu, Trishan Sandhu, Amanveer Khatkar, Tanveer Sidhu, Savreen Sohi, Simi Dhillon, and Simran Sohi. In total there were twelve parking lot attendants. Perry put in two or three hours of preliminary work before the event day, then was at the event from 5:30am - 2pm. Most volunteers put in between five and six hours of volunteer service on the race day. Tyece commented that the event was well organized, the organizers were really nice and it was fun to cheer people on during the race. Simran Sohi said, "It was nicepeople thanked us for volunteering!" Simran Grewal, Jasleen Brar, Tanjot Gill, Jessica Dhaliwal, Sanyjot Shergill, Manreet Dhaliwal, Elisha Kainth and Jasmine Aujla were part of the food prep and distribution group. Elisha stated, "This was the second year for me volunteeringthe atmosphere was amazing with the runners coming in". Gr. 10 student Jessica Dhaliwal said this was her second year volunteering, so she knew what she was doing and she volunteered a

total of ten hours: four hours from 8:30-12:30 as greeter at UFV pre-race day and then 7:00 - 12:00 at Mill Lake doing food prep. Kudos to these students for getting up early and volunteering their time and efforts for a great cause. You are a credit to our school and our community!

### **RUNNERS**

We also had a number of runners competing in the Run for Water. Grade 10 Arjun Dhillon ran the 5km race in 26 minutes, stating that "I've volunteered at the Run for Water for a number of years, this year I decided I wanted to give the run a try". Mntaj Brar and Jasman Dhaliwal both ran the 5K as well in 27 and 30 minutes respectively. Mntaj said that" It was nice to see past teachers there from our elementary school days" and Jasman said that "It's cool to see how much the event has grown over the years!" Grade 12 student Taya Fast said, "I did the 5k fun run this past Sunday for Run4water. As a team, my work (Highstreet FV) ran together. We have actually been working with run4water for the past year, kick starting mini runs in schools and hosting events because we are one of their partners. It was great to have seen it all come together". Other runners included brother and sister Parmvir and Arshdeep Waring- Parm, now in Gr. 12, finished the 5K in 17:59 minutes- first in his 17-19 age group and 4<sup>th</sup> overall for all males who completed the 5K race. Arshdeep, a Gr. 9 student, finished in 23:03 minutes- 2<sup>nd</sup> in her 14-16 age group and 7<sup>th</sup> overall for all females completing the 5K race. Impressive times!

There were a number of ATMS teachers who also ran in the Run for Water. Representing ATSS was Coach Cole and wife and late club monitor, Gerry running the 10 K and Mrs. Silzer who ran the half marathon (!!!!) in a time of 2:29, placing 11<sup>th</sup> out of 29 in her age category!!!
