## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

I would like to welcome everyone back from a Spring Break holiday. I trust everyone experienced a relaxing time although for those of us who remained in the Fraser Valley it was a wet one. I want to encourage you to stay in touch with your teachers as to the progress of your child. These last months are crucial for their success. 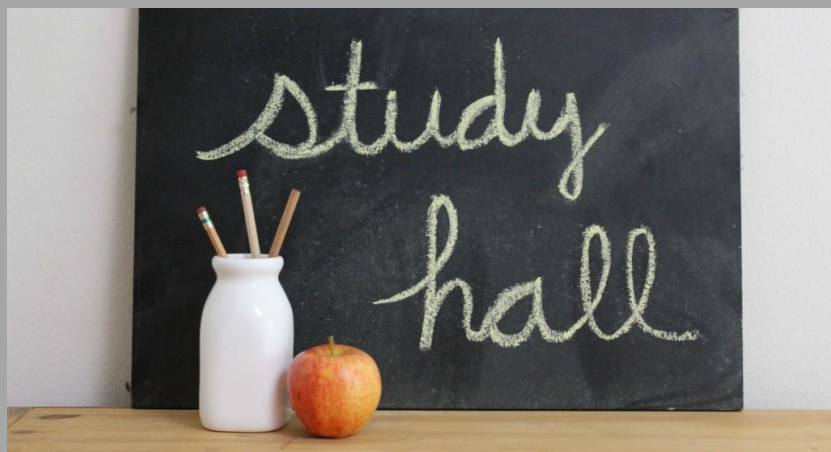

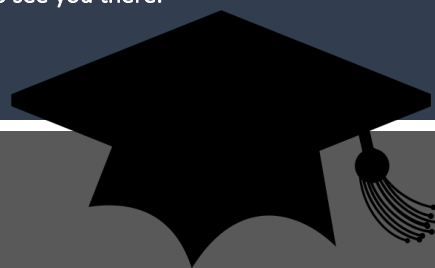
### ~VOLUNTEERS NEEDED~

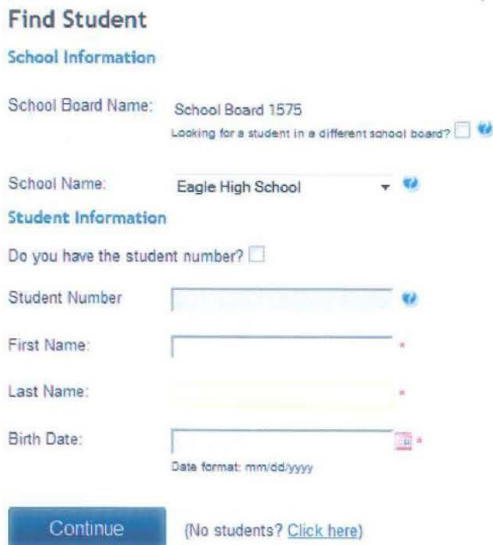
