Principal's Message

I would like to welcome everyone back for a new year here at ATSS. I trust your summer went well and it is good to see our returning students. We have had a bit of a challenge again with our Student Information System as the entire province switched over to a new system this year. This has again caused some delay in getting our students' requests for course changes completed. Unfortunately not every desired change can be accommodated as our timetable is limited by space and options. But Mr. Abernethy and Mrs. Faber, our counsellors, have been working hard to accommodate our students and their wishes.

This past Tues. our Gr. 9s have been away at a day camp where they are working on team building and ATSS culture building. We have been looking forward to this opportunity to spend some time with our new incoming students helping them to feel connected to our school in a meaningful way.

Despite the security threat we began our first full day with we have had an awesome start to the year. A couple of upcoming dates to be aware of. Our first collaboration day will be this Fri. Sept. 18 where our school will start an hour later. Dear parent/guardian/student,

Grade 9 is the last year vaccines are offered in the school setting. Public Health encourages families to review their child's vaccine records to ensure all of the provincially recommended vaccines have been received up to this age. Below is the list of recommended publicly funded 'school age' vaccines your child should have received by the end of Grade 9:

| Vaccine | Complete series includes |

| Hepatitis B <u>HealthLinkBCFile25a</u> | 2 doses (if 3 doses not received in infancy) |
| Meningococcal C vaccine <u>HealthLinkBCFile23a</u> | l dose (after 10 years of age) |
| Varicella ‡ (chickanpox) <u>HealthLinkBCFile44b</u> | 2 doses ‡ |
| HPV (girls only) (mman papillomwirus) HealthLinkBCFile101b | 2 doses |
| MMR (measles, mmaps, rubella) Healthl.inkBCFile14a | 2 doses |
| Tdap ‡‡ (totunus, diplatheria, pertussis) HealthLinhBCFile18s | l dose ‡‡ |

[‡] Children who had chickenpox or shingles disease at 1 year of age or older do not need the chickenpox vaccine.
‡ Children should already have received a primary series of Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis, and Polio prior to school entry

Because of changes to the immunization schedule and recommended number of doses for varicella, your child may not have received a second dose of varicella vaccine. If your child is missing any of the recommended immunizations, please contact your Doctor, pharmacy, or local Health Unit to make an appointment. These immunizations are provided free of charge.

After Grade 9, recommended routine adult immunizations include Td (tetanus, diphtheria) every 10 years and influenza immunization annually. For more information on childhood and adult immunizations, please visit: http://www.fraserhealth.ca/your-health/immunizations/ or http://www.immunizebc.ca/.
