Check out the Engineering Club which is meeting in Mr. Gasser's room on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays at lunch

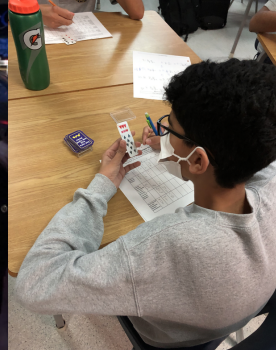
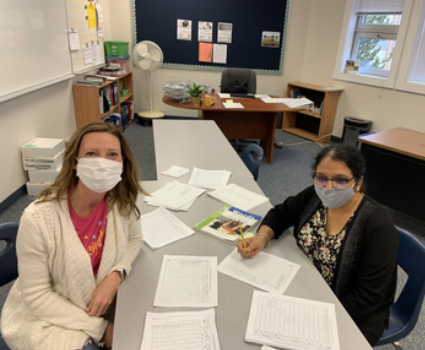
